He graduated in 1980 with a B.A. in Communications Studies/Fine Art from the University of California Santa Barbara, USA before heading to Taiwan to pursue Graduate Studies in Chinese Painting & Calligraphy at Cheng Chi University. Later through the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology, he completed a Master in Fine Art in painting. Gregory's studies have encompassed a wide range of art forms from etching and abstract painting to stained glass, cartoon animation and photography.

Since being awarded the Tom Allen Award, Santa Cruz, California in 1984, Gregory's collections have spanned the globe, from the TYPA Community Center, Taipei, to Nokia Telecommunications in Singapore and the most recent in Utrecht, New Jersey. His work has found universal recognition with exhibitions in Hong Kong, Singapore, Indonesia, India, Taiwan, Japan, Australia, Spain, Italy, UK and USA.

Gregory is also a Paralympian, setting four world records in swimming during the Paralympics in Barcelona, Atlanta and Sydney. He lives in Singapore and California where he finds inspiration in natural and architectural imagery, and continues his teaching of twenty years to both individuals and select groups.
